

PROBATION STUDENTS

Students who have earned a cumulative GPA of less than 2.0 and/or a rate of satisfactory course completion less than 67% will be placed on academic probation. While on probation, a registration hold will be placed on student records which will require formal probation advisor approval prior to registration for the following semester and for any subsequent probationary semester(s).

Probation means that you must participate in the probationary advising process based on your major. Contact the appropriate Probationary Advisor/Advising Center in the college of your major early in the semester (see list below). Failure to participate in the probationary advising process will make you ineligible to register for the following semester. After two terms on probation, if your cumulative GPA is not at 2.00 or above, and/or your cumulative course completion rate is not at 67% or above, you will be placed on academic suspension.
