1/ We discussed the chemistry class submitted. There has yet to be a companion proposal from HP for this cross listed course. (#50)

2/We discussed a proposal from Chemistry & Geology course proposal Forensic Science 131 (#53). Dick Liebendorfer moved, Gretta Handke seconded approval for this course for categories 3 & 9.

3/We discussed the Perspectives in Technology class(#). While this sounds like a great class, discussion centered around whether the class meets the definitions in Category 6, which most felt it did not. The motion was made by Dick Liebendorfer & seconded by Kellian Clink that the course be rejected for category 6. Vote was 4 in favor of rejection, 2 nays. This Humanities topics course has been used by SET students and this decision takes effect (IMMEDIATELY, RON? Or starting Spring 2006?) but does not impact those who have already taken this class for this category in the past. This raises the questions of the topics courses and the review process of them for Gen Ed.

4/Two courses, Asian (#141) and Islamic art (#) are 4/500 classes and therefore not Gen Eds.

5/The Introduction to Dance (#132) course proposal lacks information we need to make a decision. Dick Liebendorfer will talk to the department.

6/The Human Sexuality proposal was discussed (#99). Gretta moved and Dick seconded approval for Categories 5 & 7. Ayes were unanimous.

7/We discussed the Diversity Curriculum's work.
