There was a discussion of student appeals.

Cassandra Masters had an appeal to accept Anthropology 220 for Category 3L. Due to errors in getting approval of this course into the bulletin, it was not officially listed at the time she took the course. Paul Brown stated it should have been approved at the time. The appeal was approved because of errors.

Alicia Faulk had an appeal for Category 1c. She had been advised she didn't need a course in this category because she had taken Soc 101. It appeared that the Soc 101 class she took at that time did not satisfy this category at that time. The appeal was approved because she was misadvised. However it was agreed that she could not substitute KSP 235 for this category. The original Soc 101 would be accepted.

The minutes of 9/24 and 10/1 were approved.

There was a discussion of guidelines for 4 Credit General Education Courses. Nickerson had provided a draft policy. The draft was approved.
