



**2009 UIFI Funding Application**  
**Due by 4:30 p.m. on Friday, April 3**

The Undergraduate Interfraternity Institute (UIFI) is an intense leadership experience that will draw 80-90 fraternity and sorority leaders from all over the country together in one place. The institute will take place 8 times during Summer 2009. UIFI is intended for those who are ready to take the concept of "leadership" to the next level. It will focus on values-based leadership and will challenge participants to think beyond the basics of chapter or community operations. MSU Greek Life is pleased to be able to provide the opportunity for one student to attend UIFI. There may be potential for a second opportunity. If this is the case, one member of an Interfraternity Council chapter and one member of a Panhellenic Council chapter will be selected. Although attendance at UIFI is open to any Greek student, eligibility requirements for this funding opportunity include:

- a. Sophomore or Junior standing with anticipated graduation date no earlier than Fall 2010.
- b. Minimum 2.5 cumulative **AND** previous semester GPA.

Preferred consideration will be given to those applicants who show particular potential for assuming leadership roles in their chapters and the MSU Greek Community.

This funding will cover the \$435 registration cost for UIFI. The cost of transportation to and from Bloomington, IN or Los Angeles, CA, and any other expenses will be the responsibility of the person selected and/or his/her chapter or council.

Applicants are asked to both complete the attached form and to answer the following questions on a separate sheet of paper:

1. What do you hope to gain from the UIFI experience?
2. How could your participation in UIFI benefit your chapter and MSU's Greek Community?
3. What leadership roles have you held within your chapter or the Greek Community and/or what leadership roles do you *hope to hold* within your chapter or the Greek Community?

Greek Community members selected are expected to abide by all university, organization and UIFI policies. They are expected to participate in all aspects of the UIFI program and may be asked to assist with presentations related to the UIFI curriculum once they return to campus.

If a recipient of this award registers for UIFI and must cancel, does not show up, or otherwise causes the forfeiture of any portion of the university-paid registration cost, the recipient will be required to repay the forfeited portion.
