# Ports of Call

## STOCKHOLM, SWEDEN

Spend a marvelous day discovering this lovely city and its beautiful buildings. Visit the charming Old Town, medieval Gamla Stan; the elegant Royal Palace, the wonderful parks and the impressive Vasa, the magnificently restored 17th-century warship that sank in the harbor on her maiden voyage!

## HELSINKI, FINLAND

Admire the city's stunning modern architecture, visit its lovely parks and bustling open-air market. Take a harbor cruise past forests, beaches, villas and ruined Suomenlinna fortress spanning five islands for a completely different perspective. Or visit historic, colorful Porvoo, Finland's second oldest town.

## ST. PETERSBURG, RUSSIA

Explore breathtaking St. Petersburg and cruise its canals. Visit the Peter and Paul Fortress, the fabulous onion-domed cathedrals, and the palaces – from the immense Winter Palace, now the Hermitage Museum, to the fabled Catherine's Palace and Peterhof outside the city. Enjoy an evening of ballet or traditional Russian song and dance or take a day trip to Moscow.

## MOSCOW, RUSSIA

A unique opportunity to explore the Russian capital in one day. After a brief forty-five minute flight from St. Petersburg, your coach tour includes the Kremlin and its Armory Museum with its splendid display of carriages, costumes and other Tsar treasures including the world famous Faberge eggs; Cathedral Square; and Assumption Cathedral. After lunch, continue on to Christ Savior Cathedral, and Red Square, to see the Kremlin Walls, Lenin's Tomb, St. Basil's Cathedral and the Bolshoi Theater. Free time at the iconic G.U.M. department store, then a return flight to St. Petersburg.

## TALLINN, ESTONIA

Step back in time as you walk through this beautifully preserved medieval town and discover its upper and lower levels, the Guild Houses, the churches and squares, the famous Apothecary shop and the exquisite Town Hall. See delightful parks, Baroque palaces and a ruined 15th-century convent. Or visit a lovely recreated rural Estonian village by the sea.

## RIGA, LATVIA

The capital of Latvia and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the lavish and vibrant metropolis of Riga has been deemed the "Paris of the East." Cobble medieval streets, Art Nouveau architecture, large parks, and an historic Old Quarter combined with hip restaurants, glitzy hotels, and a buzzing nightlife, make Riga a top European destination.

## VISBY, SWEDEN

A medieval town on the Swedish island of Gotland, and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Visby was once home to the ancient Goths. Best explored on foot, Visby offers cobble streets, picturesque cottages, botanical gardens, medieval ruins, and sixteen ancient churches.

## COPENHAGEN, DENMARK

See another side of this lovely city with a cruise along its charming canals. Visit the quaint old harbor at Nyhavn and beautiful Rosenborg Castle and, the famed statue of the Little Mermaid. Or venture into the countryside and enjoy its panoramic vistas, fairy-tale castles and the village of Fredensborg.

## BERLIN (WARNEMUNDE), GERMANY

Enjoy a scenic drive to the German capital and savor landmarks like the Brandenburg Gate and the glorious Charlottenburg Palace. Stroll down Unter den Linden, see the site of the Berlin Wall and take a boat ride along the city's canals. Or discover charming Warnemünde and its lovely Gothic Church, market square and seaside promenade.

## AMSTERDAM, NETHERLANDS

Take a boat ride along Amsterdam's charming canals past sturdy old houses and under quaint bridges. Visit one of the city's superb museums housing many of the Dutch Masters' most outstanding works or learn about Anne Frank and the city's Jewish heritage. Or journey into the countryside and see historic windmills and the fascinating porcelain works in Delft.

## BRUGES (ZEEBREGGE), BELGIUM

Step back in time to the 14th century as you meander along the narrow streets of this medieval gem past gabled buildings and through the bustling market. Take a boat ride along the city's canals. Or spend the day exploring Brussels and its famed Grand Place or Antwerp, home of diamonds, Rubens and Bruegel, seeing the verdant countryside along the way.
