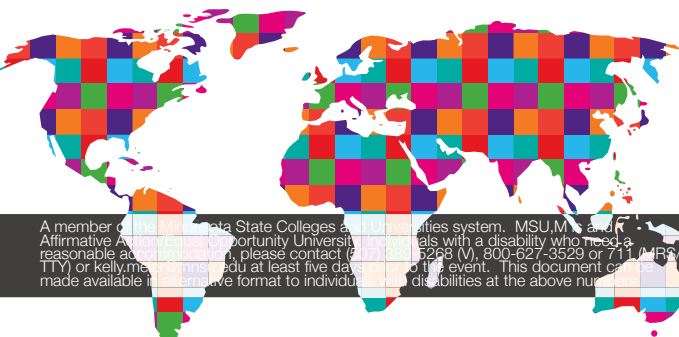
All participants will receive a **certificate** stating that they received this training and a Safe Zone Certification Record.
