Please describe your strengths and limitations in the applicant letter. (Please note: you may be required to provide documentation of your disability.)
2. Transcript  
Provide a current transcript from Minnesota State University, Mankato. If you are an incoming freshman or transfer student, please provide a transcript from your high school or previously attended college or university.
3. Two Letters of Recommendation

One letter must be from a professional who is knowledgeable about your academic qualities and accomplishments and one from a person who is knowledgeable about your personal qualities.
