POSITION: Adjunct Faculty, Department of Art

DATE OF APPOINTMENT: Beginning of each academic semester.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Department of Art occasionally has part-time openings in studio art, graphic design, art history and/or art education. The department is currently seeking applicants to teach the following course:

Studio: Fall and spring semesters, 2009-2010: Art 302 Interactive Design Survey (3 credits)

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A BFA, MA or MFA in art.
- Experience in the graphic design field and skills in dreamweaver, flash, photoshop and illustrator are required to teach Art 302.

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS:

- Previous teaching experience at the college level is desirable.
- Demonstrated commitment to fostering a diverse working and learning environment.

RELATED INFORMATION:

Adjunct appointments are made from the pool of available applicants. Appointments may be continued beyond the initial semester, contingent upon satisfactory performance and available funds. Adjunct faculty are subject to student and faculty evaluation.

The Department of Art has over 300 majors, 15 faculty and several adjunct instructors. It offers the BA, BFA, BS, and MA degrees and is accredited by the National Association of Schools of Art and Design.
