The Chemical Hygiene Officer at Minnesota State University Mankato will implement and maintain compliance of the University's Chemical Hygiene Plan (CHP) and Laboratory Safety programs in accordance with applicable local, state and federal laws and rules. This position will also assist with the University's hazardous wastes including asbestos abatement activities.

Extensive knowledge of Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) regulations pertaining to laboratory environments required. This position also requires extensive knowledge in the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) as well as Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) Hazardous Waste regulations.
