U.S. Immigration law requires international students to ENROLL IN AND COMPLETE a full-time course of study during each Fall and Spring Semester. Full-time study is defined as twelve (12) credit hours for undergraduates and six (6) credit hours for graduate students. Audited courses DO NOT count toward full-time enrollment. Students are required to meet with an international student advisor BEFORE dropping below the required number of credit hours in order to remain in status with the Department of Homeland Security (DHS).

Certain circumstances are permitted for reduced course loads. The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has approved the following circumstances. Since you are in the best position to supply information about this student's academic situation, we are asking you to indicate which of the following situations, if any, explains why the student will not register full-time. International students with a temporary illness or medical condition do not need an academic advisor's signature. - ____ 8. is enrolled concurrently at another college/university. Total credit hours taken at MSU and host institution must equal full-time enrollment.

- ____ 9. authorized early official withdrawal from MSU – Student must depart U.S. within 15 days of withdrawal (must present airline ticket or proof of departure plans)
