Application Deadline: May 9, 2008. Late or incomplete applications will **NOT** be considered.

SELECTION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Graduate applicants must have earned 3.0 GPA for Spring Semester or 3.25 cumulative and completed 6 new graduate credits with a letter grade (or a combination of 9 undergraduate and graduate credits).
2. Undergraduate applicants must have earned a 2.5 GPA for Spring Semester or 3.0 cumulative and completed 12 new credits of letter grade.

4. All new In-State Scholarship Recipients are **REQUIRED** to attend an Informational Meeting at the beginning of the semester awarded. Check the IC Bulletin Board for more details or check the IC Website at: www.mnsu.edu/ic for details.

Graduates will be allowed a maximum of 2.5 years of In-State Scholarship starting from the first semester of graduate work at MSU, Mankato. All semesters of non-enrollment will be included in the maximum limit. Academic performance and verified contribution hours will be evaluated each semester excluding Summer session(s). Scholarship recipients who do not fulfill the requirements will be terminated from the program, and after one semester off the program, may reapply for the Scholarship. New recipients will be notified via e-mail after the beginning of the semester. The scholarship is canceled when Graduate students accept an assistantship.
