Free Parking – Where

- Free Lot 23 (across from CVS Pharmacy Drug Store).
- Nighttime enforcement of violations for “no permit” ends at 6:30 P.M. though coverage will still be maintained for residence hall parking and handicap parking. Permit enforcement of Gold and Purple and Orange permit stalls will not occur between 6:30 P.M. and 2:00 A.M.
- Special event parking where organizers have obtained prior permission for free parking in lots 21, 22 or 23.
- Green, Purple, and Orange permit stalls.

- 6:00 A.M. to 2:00 A.M.
- 6:30 P.M. to 2:00 A.M.
Monday-Friday
- 6:00 A.M. to 2:00 A.M.
Saturday and Sunday
- As approved on individual basis
Interims & Summer Session

All enforcement begins first day of classes in late August. Exceptions include Nighttime Purple after the first week of each semester.

Parking prohibited in all lots and on-street parking areas between 2:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M. without special permission from Parking and Traffic Services Coordinator.

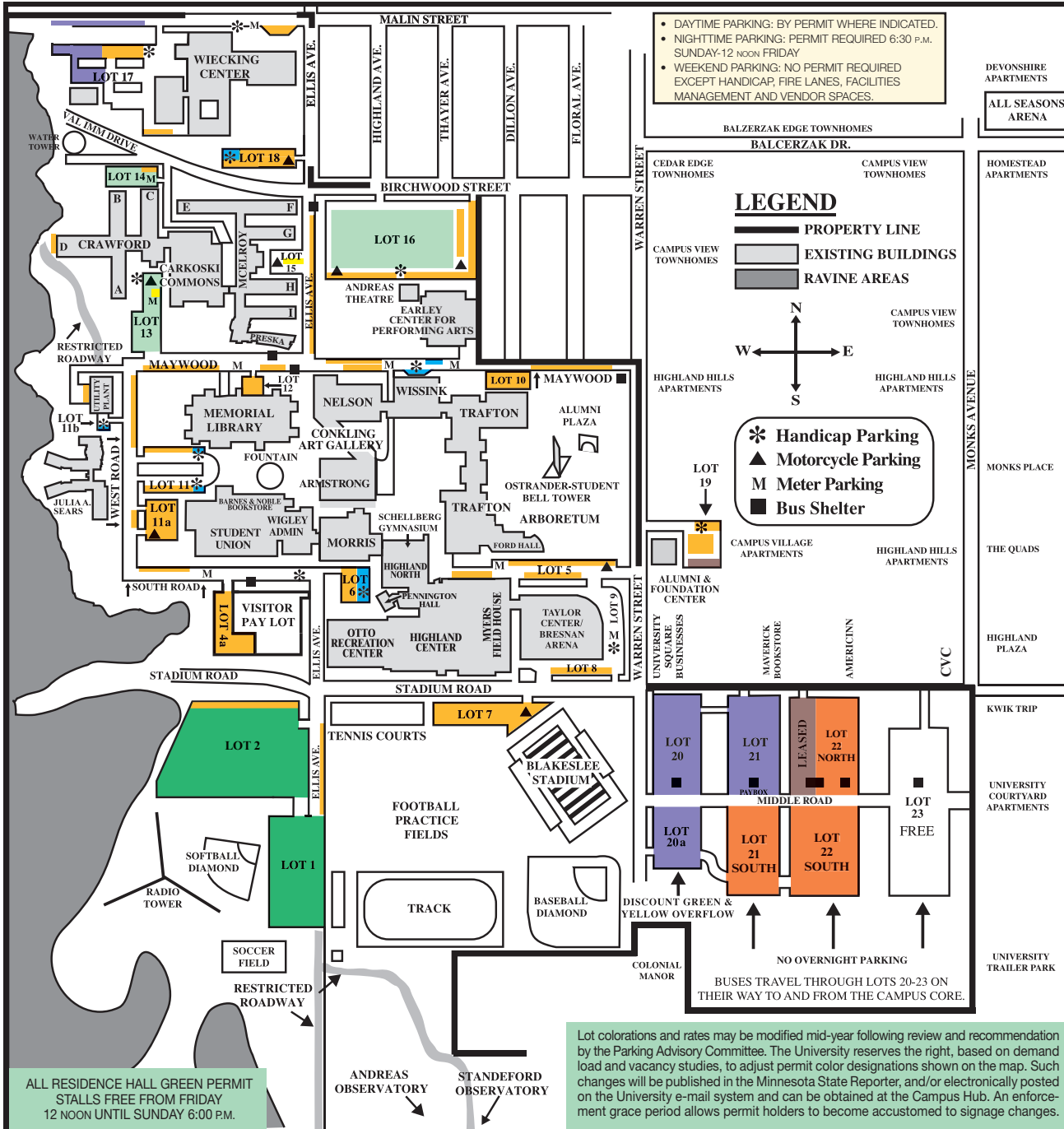
