### Disability Parking Permits

Disability accessible parking is provided in specially designated close-in areas. Disability accessible stalls are enforced on a 24-hour basis. Assuming nearby disability stalls are occupied, blue permit holders may park in Reserved Gold, General Purple, Green permit spaces, or timed meter stalls.

Because lot maintenance costs need to be shared by all permit holders, the University requires the purchase of a blue Disability parking permit by faculty, staff, and students who qualify to park in disability stalls. Visitors with state issued disability parking permits and/or license plates may park without the Minnesota State Mankato blue permit.

### Temporary Disability Parking Permits:

Temporary disability parking permits can be purchased at the Campus Hub. Medical documentation in the form of a State of MN Disability Parking Permit application, signed and completed by a physician is required. ### Report Needed Repairs or Snow/Ice issues:

Report non-emergency repair requests or snow/ice removal issues by submitting an online Work Order Request through the Facilities Management Web site at [www.mnsu.edu/facilities/](http://www.mnsu.edu/facilities/) (click on "Work Order Request" in the quick links). This system takes approximately 24 hours so please do not use this site to submit emergency requests. Emergency requests can be phoned to 507-389-2071 during daytime hours and 507-389-2111 during nights and weekends.

### Priority Snow Routes:

Priority Snow Routes indicate the campus sidewalks that are first to be cleared during a snow event and monitored frequently to improve access. Ultimately, all walkways are cleared, but knowing the priority routes may help in the early hours of a heavy snowfall.

### Housing Accommodations for Students with Disabilities:

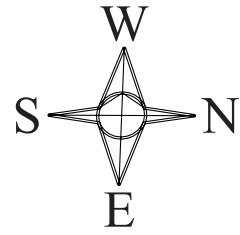
### Telephone Access for Individuals with Hearing Impairments:

### Partially Accessible Buildings

Andreas Observatory – Direct access to the observatory building is available from the adjacent parking spaces. The building has accessible bathrooms. The dome containing the main telescope is accessible via a long concrete ramp with 5 percent grade. Images from the telescope and dome may be viewed remotely from the main building using a video system.

Blakeslee Stadium – Restrooms are not accessible and ramp into stadium exceeds 5 percent grade.
