Graduate Faculty Status Policy

Policy language clarifying the documents required as part of the nominating process will be reflected in a revised version of the policy.

Additional suggested policy changes submitted by the chairs of the College of Science, Engineering, and Technology were discussed. Discussion of the suggestion concerning the graduate faculty status of probationary hires will resume in the fall. The other suggestion concerns the timing of the applications for graduate faculty status. Dr. Page and Dr. Blackhurst will visit with the appropriate campus constituencies to determine the viability of requiring applications to be submitted and reviewed in the fall, rather than in the spring.

Graduate Faculty Roster

The roster of Research Faculty nominees was approved.

In a separate motion, the members of the Sub-meet approved the suggestion that Dr. Blackhurst notify Research Faculty nominees of their approval status. Approved nominees with missing credentials will be informed that approval is contingent upon submission of the missing documents.
