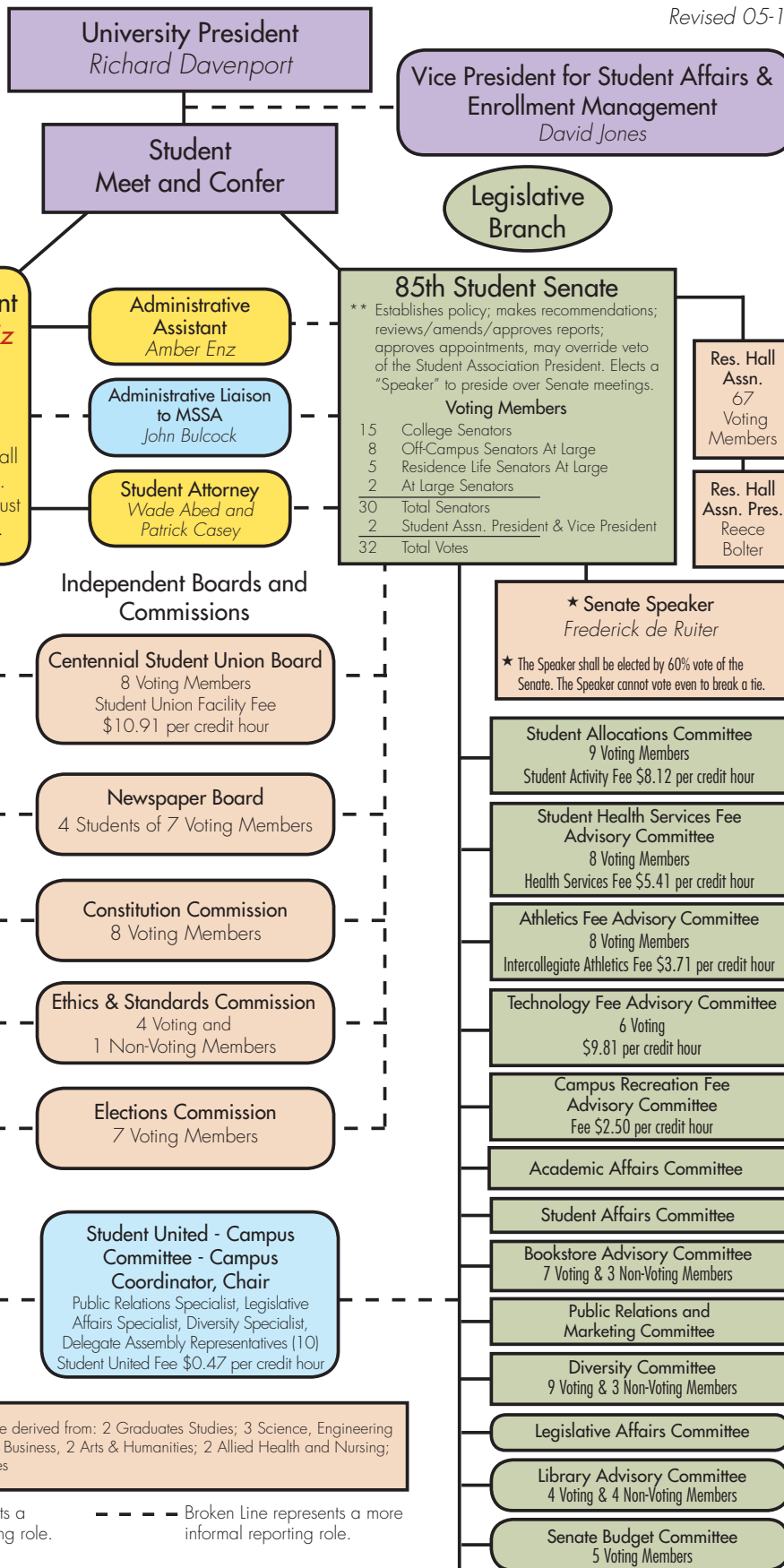

(Elected by and from among the Student Association)
May Veto Senate Action
Is an ex-officio non-voting member of all Association Boards and Committees. Makes all appointments which then must be approved by the Student Senate.

** Establishes policy; makes recommendations; reviews/amends/approves reports; approves appointments, may override veto of the Student Association President. Elects a "Speaker" to preside over Senate meetings.
