- **ELIGIBILITY:** Students who are currently enrolled in grades 6-12.
- **REPERTOIRE:** Repertoire may be chosen from the Baroque through the 20th century style periods. Repertoire must be memorized if selected for the Saturday master class competition.
- **AUDITION RECORDING:** The audition process requires that each applicant send an unedited audio recording (CD, DVD video, audiocassette tape) of the applicant's performance piece. Please label the audio recording with the applicant's name and title of the repertoire piece. Applicant's performance piece must not exceed 10 minutes.
- **APPLICATION PROCESS:** A completed application form (enclosed), audio recording, and a \$20 application fee payable to the MSU Performance Series must be postmarked no later than Friday, January 27, 2012. The application fee is non-refundable. Applicant priority given by the date of postmark. Teachers are required to furnish their recommendation and comments on the application.

 - Second Place \$200
 - Third Place \$100
- **DEADLINE:** Friday, January 27, 2012
Successful applicants will be notified by Friday, February 3, 2012.
