

Jenson Scholarship

For part-time non-traditional students in the Fall semester

Students that apply for, but are not awarded the Weigel Scholarship for the spring semester are eligible to be considered for the Jenson Scholarship during the fall. The Jenson Scholarship is a \$500 scholarship for the Fall semester only. In order to be considered you must:

- Continue to be a part-time student for Fall of 2006 (take fewer than 12 credits)
- Have a Free Application For Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)* submitted to the federal processor by March 15, 2006 for the Fall semester
- Have a demonstrated need based on your FAFSA information

**The FAFSA is the application for need-based financial aid. You will not be considered for the Jenson Scholarship unless you submit a FAFSA for the fall semester of 2006. Only students who have a need calculated through the FAFSA process will be eligible to receive the Jenson Scholarship.
