Except when a holiday falls on a class day, enforcement of parking rules on national holidays shall be limited to handicap stalls, fire lanes and other safety related areas.

### Free Parking – Where

- Free Lot 23 (across from CVS Pharmacy Drug Store).
- Permit enforcement of Gold and Purple and Orange permit stalls will not occur between 6:30 P.M. and 2:00 A.M.
- Special event parking where organizers have obtained prior permission for free parking in Lots 21, 22 or 23.
- Green, Purple, and Orange permit stalls.

Exceptions include Nighttime Purple after the first week of each semester.*

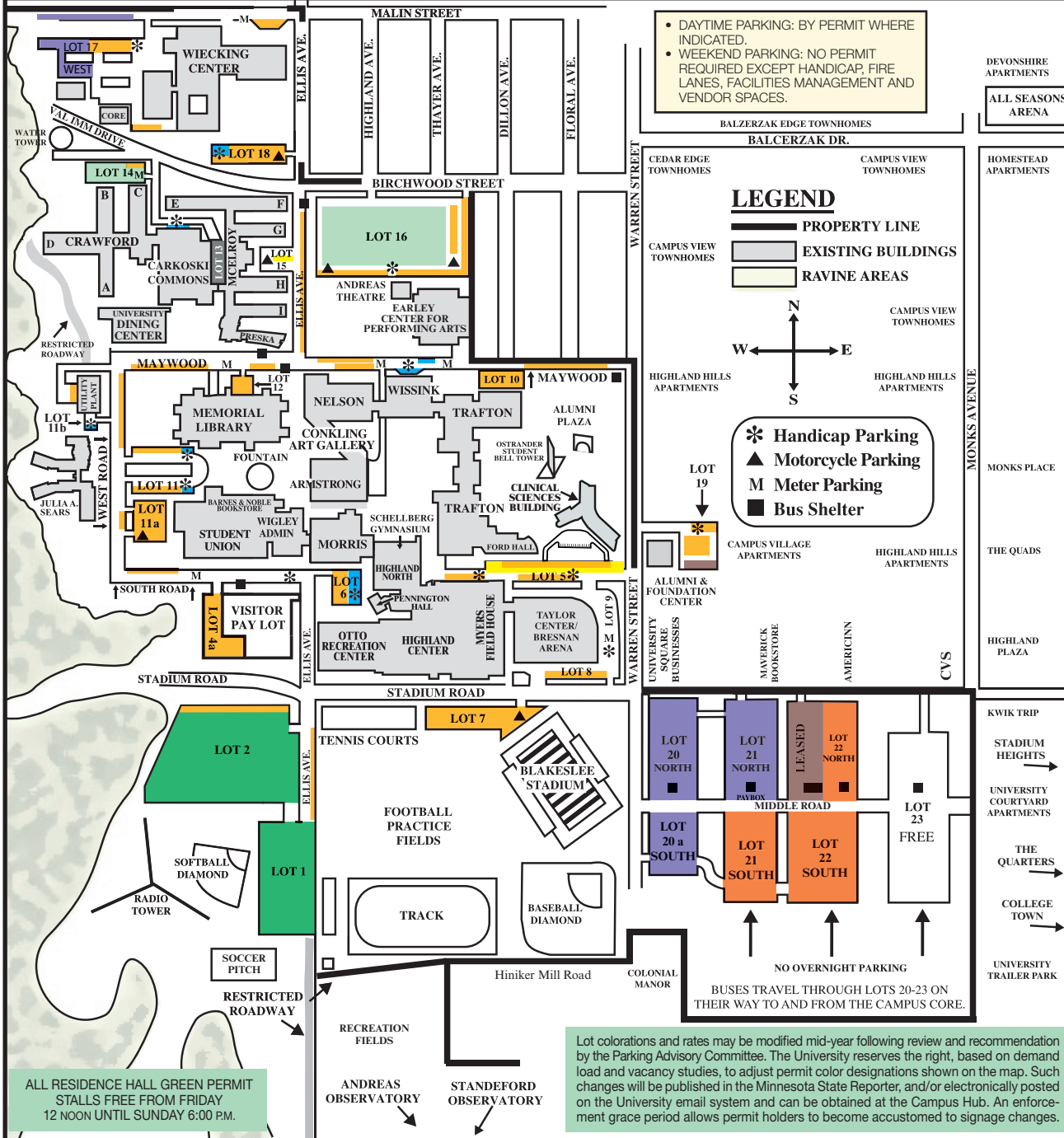

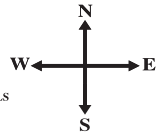

Lot colorations and rates may be modified mid-year following review and recommendation by the Parking Advisory Committee. The University reserves the right, based on demand load and vacancy studies, to adjust permit color designations shown on the map. Such changes will be published in the Minnesota State Reporter, and/or electronically posted on the University email system and can be obtained at the Campus Hub. An enforcement grace period allows permit holders to become accustomed to signage changes.

After 4:00 P.M. they can park in any gold permit stall regardless of the lot designation on the face of the gold parking permit.	\$ 330
	<b>Nighttime gold</b> permits are available to purple or orange permit holders (both an individual's regular permit and nighttime gold must be hanging at the same time). Nighttime gold may park in any regular gold permit stall after 4:00 P.M. Monday thru Thursday.	\$ 38 per semester
PL	<b>Platinum</b> \$ 350 Academic year; \$ 210 Spring/Summer; \$ 70 Summer Platinum permit holders can park 24/7 in the Platinum Lot 13 between McElroy and Carkoski Commons.	\$ 350 \$ 210 Spring \$ 70 Summer

GR	<b>Green - Close-In On-Campus Residence Hall Parking</b> \$ 272 Academic year; \$ 136 Spring Residence hall parking is divided into two areas: Lot 16 green across from McElroy; Preska; and Lot 14 near Crawford C Hall; if full Lot 1. Must be a residence hall student.	\$ 272
DGR	<b>Dark Green - Gage Zone On-Campus Residence Hall Parking</b> \$ 210 Academic year; \$ 105 Spring Discount residence hall parking. Dark green permit holders park in Lot 1 and 2. Must be a residence hall student. Nighttime Red Eye Shuttle service provided; Free Daytime Maverick Shuttles provided.	\$ 210
LB	<b>Light Blue - Vendor Delivery Services Zone</b> \$ 330 Twelve-month year; \$ 198 Spring/Summer; \$ 66 Summer Must park in specially signed areas; A paper "temporary" permit is available for \$5 per day, \$20 per week.	\$ 330
DB	<b>Dark Blue - Handicap</b> \$ 148 Twelve-month year; \$ 88 Spring/Summer; \$ 24 Summer Holders of the handicap permit can park in any handicap stall or if full, any gold permit, purple permit, green permit, or time meter stalls. For University students or employees a special University blue hanging handicap permit is required beyond the state issued handicap dashboard permits or license plates. The University permit required 6:00 A.M. to 6:30 P.M. Monday thru Thursday; 6:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. Friday. Handicap dashboard certificate and/or license plate required at all times.	\$ 148

B	<b>Brown - Contract Parking</b> Lot 19 and 22 Brown Contract Parking plastic permits are only available to University Square Village tenants and are issued by University Square Village, not MSU. Tailwind Group "Lots @ 1633" on Monks also leases Lot 22 Brown Permit stalls.	Varies
R	<b>Red - \$ 60 Fall-Summer; \$ 38 Spring/Summer; \$ 19 Summer</b> Overnight parking for Minnesota State Mankato night shift employees in special designated areas. Gold, Purple, and Orange permit holders may apply for a red overnight permit which are issued free by facilities services manager.
