Large purple wrapped buses take passengers to nearby apartment complexes as part of "U-Zone." A Downtown Express (Route 7) exists to provide a 5-minute ride to downtown Mankato grocery stores, social security offices, and civic center. There are different routes to reach a variety of destinations. Free with your MavCard.
