Meeting Agenda Approved

It was noted that the meeting agenda for November 9 would be used again as the agenda for November 16th.

Meeting Minutes Reviewed

The meeting minutes of November 9th were then reviewed. Corrections made included the spelling of Kellie Lattin's name and changing the Lot 8 reference on page 3 to Lot 18. Without objection the meeting minutes were then approved as corrected.

Consideration of the Tabled Bohnenblust Motion

PAC members then continued debating aspects of the four major points contained in the motion presented by Steve Bohnenblust and seconded by Rose Marie Ley on November 2nd. The motion was subsequently divided at the November 9th meeting with parts 1 and 3 merged - that combined language was changed and adopted as follows:

Gold permit space shall be allocated on a priority basis for faculty and staff. Leftover or unsold Gold permits would be allocated for off-campus student customers.

Discussion on parts 2 and 4 then occurred for the balance of the November 16th meeting. Parts two and four state:

- 75 Green residence hall slots from Lot 13 and/or Lot 3 be converted to Gold.
- Gold prices be frozen for two years (2002-03 and 2003-04).

Stephen Bohnenblust moved and Rose Marie Ley seconded that part 4 on the freezing of Gold permit prices be tabled. Motion carried.

Karen Hadley indicated the perhaps the existing \$138 price for light Green permits was too low given the close-in convenient location of the Green permit stalls. However, a major price increase will be extremely hard on students and should not be seriously considered. A way should be found for such permits to be paid in segments throughout the academic year. Rose Marie Ley agreed indicating that other permit types should be afforded the same privilege.

It was agreed to further discussion of the proposal to convert Green permit stalls until Residence Hall Association leaders could meet with the RHA. Stephen Bohnenblust indicated that he would be willing to meet with students during the next meeting of the RHA.

Adjournment

Without objection, the meeting was adjourned at 2:25 PM.
