### Program Description:

The Dietetic Program at Minnesota State Mankato provides students pursuing a dietetics career the highest quality advisory, academic and interactive opportunities and to develop their confidence and competency for advancement following graduation to supervised practice, graduate studies and related employment. All dietetics majors are part of the DPD, and accredited four-year program that is the first of four steps toward becoming a Registered Dietitian (RD). Dietetic majors study foods, food service management, nutrition, community nutrition and medical nutrition therapy. This major helps prepare men and women as clinical, administrative/managerial and community dietitians

### Admission Requirements:

To be permanently admitted to the Department of Family Consumer Science, a student must:


1. Be a declared major in FCS
2. Have an advisor assigned
3. Have completed a minimum of 32 semester hours
4. have reached a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50
