### Program Description:

Psychology is the scientific study of the effects of individual, social, physiological, developmental and environmental factors on thoughts, feelings and behavior. Psychology courses seek to teach students about the methods of psychological inquiry and the findings of psychological research.

Students study psychology because they wish to prepare for a professional career as a psychologist, because they are planning a career in which the understanding of human behavior is important, or simply because they wish to develop a greater understanding of themselves and others. The practice of psychology at a professional level requires a graduate degree beyond the four-year undergraduate degree.

### Admission Requirements:

1. A minimum of 32 earned semester credit hours
  2. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 ("C")
  3. Completion of PSYC 201 (Statistics) with a grade of "C" or better
- Contact the department for application procedures.

### Advising:

You are expected to meet with your advisor on a regular basis to ensure courses are taken in an order that will lead to successful completion of the degree.
