### Program Description:

Sociology is the scientific study of society and culture examining patterns of human social behavior. The sociology program at Minnesota State University Mankato is dedicated to the pursuit, transmission and application of sociological knowledge in order to understand and transform the social world. - a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00.
