

## CALENDAR OPTIONS

- A. One ten-week session and two five-week (First Session, Second Session) sessions will be scheduled for Summer 2012.
- B. Four two-week modules will be arranged. Classes scheduled in modules shall have all of the characteristics of regular courses. All two-week courses should fit the module timeline. Modules begin June 4 and end July 27 according to the schedule on the next page.
- C. The workshop program of previous years will be retained. Workshops are offerings in which the major learning activity takes place during the regularly scheduled class periods. Because of this, each workshop requires a minimum of 18 contact hours per credit hour.
- D. Flexible Scheduling Option may be utilized according to the guidelines.
- E. Evening classes may be scheduled.

### CLASS HOURS (ON-CAMPUS COURSES) FIVE-WEEK SESSION CLASSES

Three-credit classes meet for one period daily with periods corresponding to the schedule below. Two-credit courses meet four times weekly and one-credit courses meet twice weekly with periods arranged to correspond to the schedule below.
