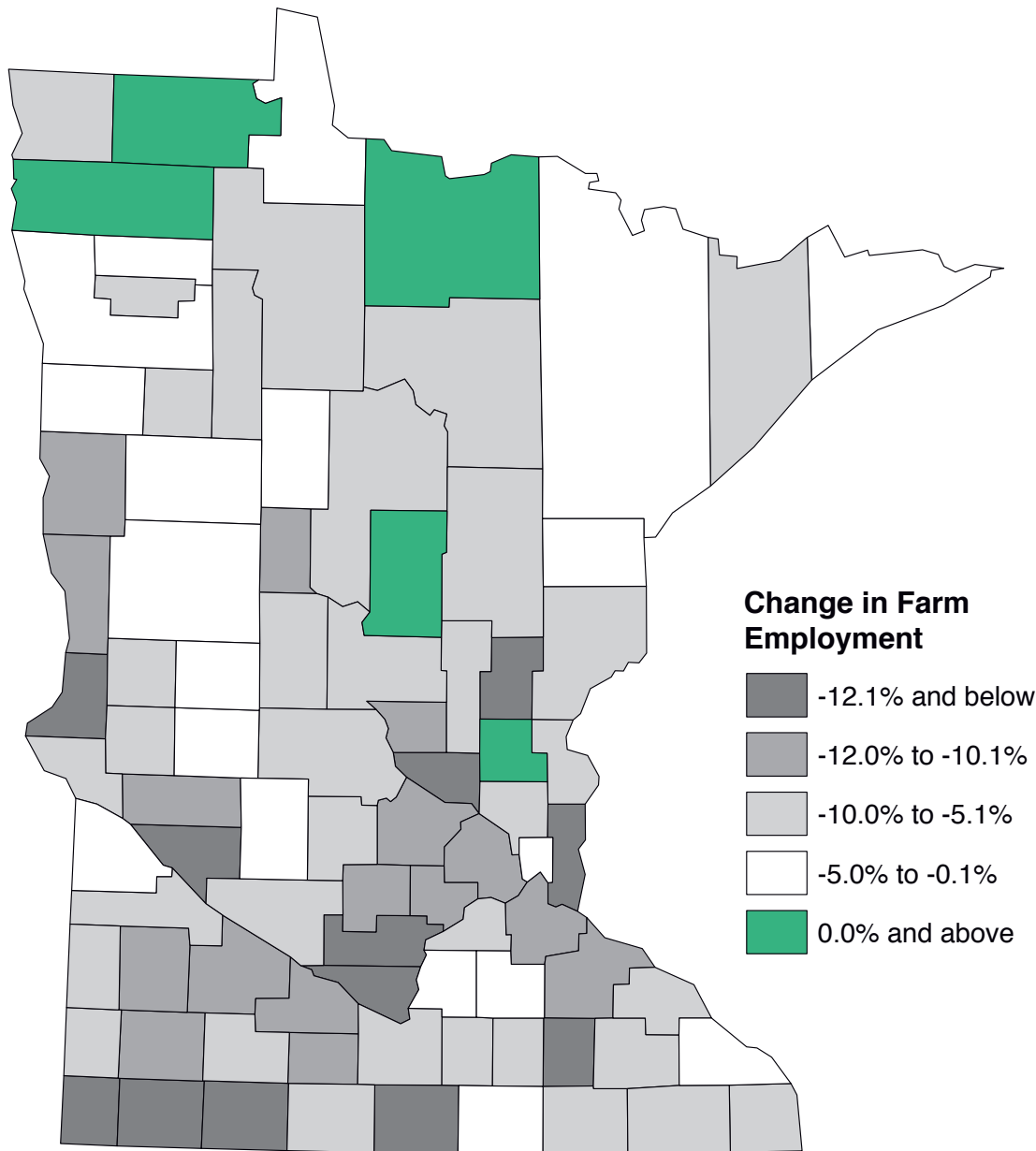


Change in Farm Employment, 1994–2004

Between 1994 and 2004, the number of people working on farms decreased in the state as a whole by 7.6%. Most counties also saw a decrease in their farm employment; only five counties actually saw an increase. The largest increase was in Roseau County at 3.3%, while the largest decrease was in Washington County, at -19.7%.
