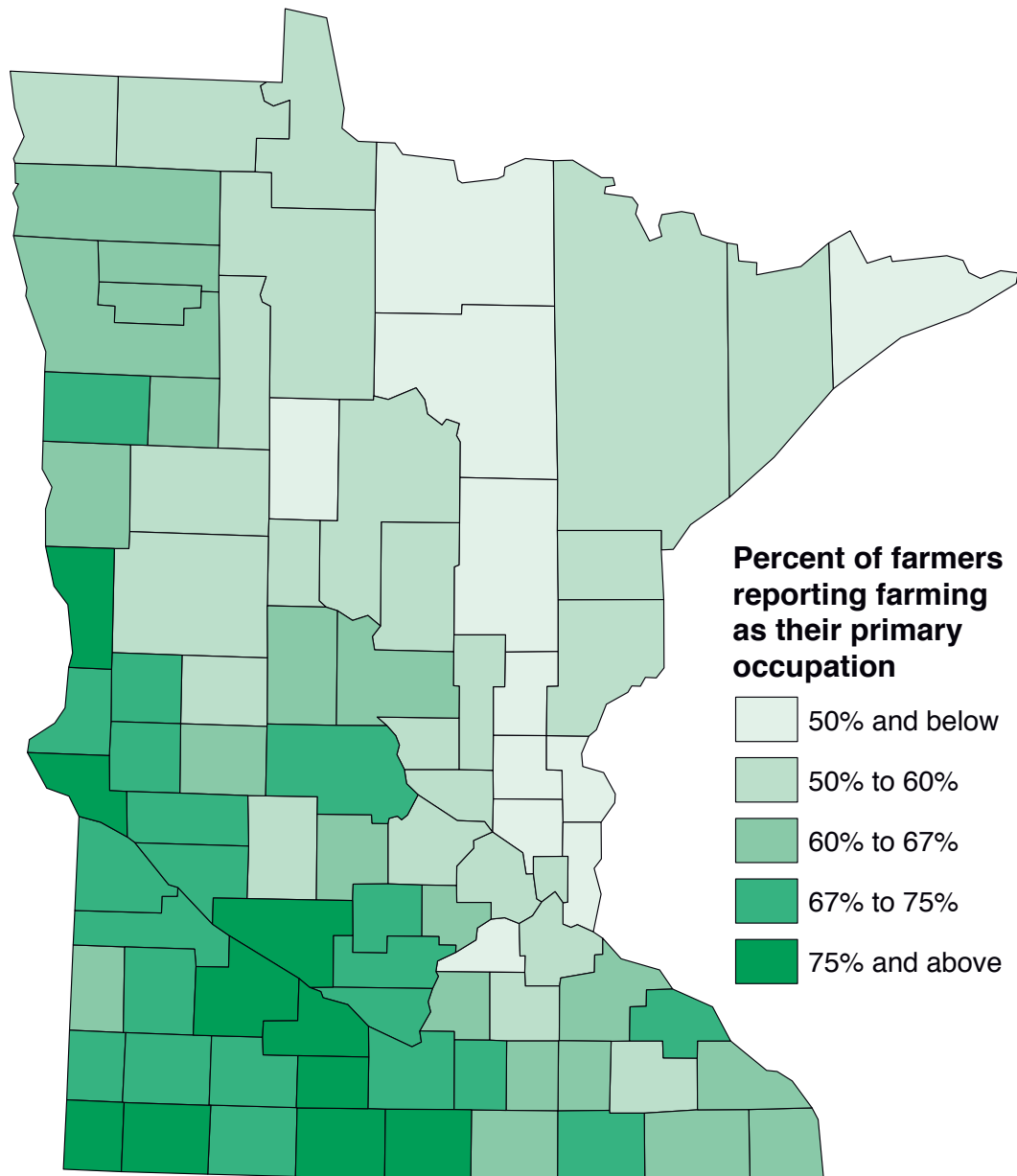


Farming as a Primary Occupation, 2002

Producers whose primary occupation is farming devote more than half of their time to it. A larger percentage of producers in southern and western Minnesota than farmers in other regions consider farming their primary occupation. The average for the state was 62.9%.
