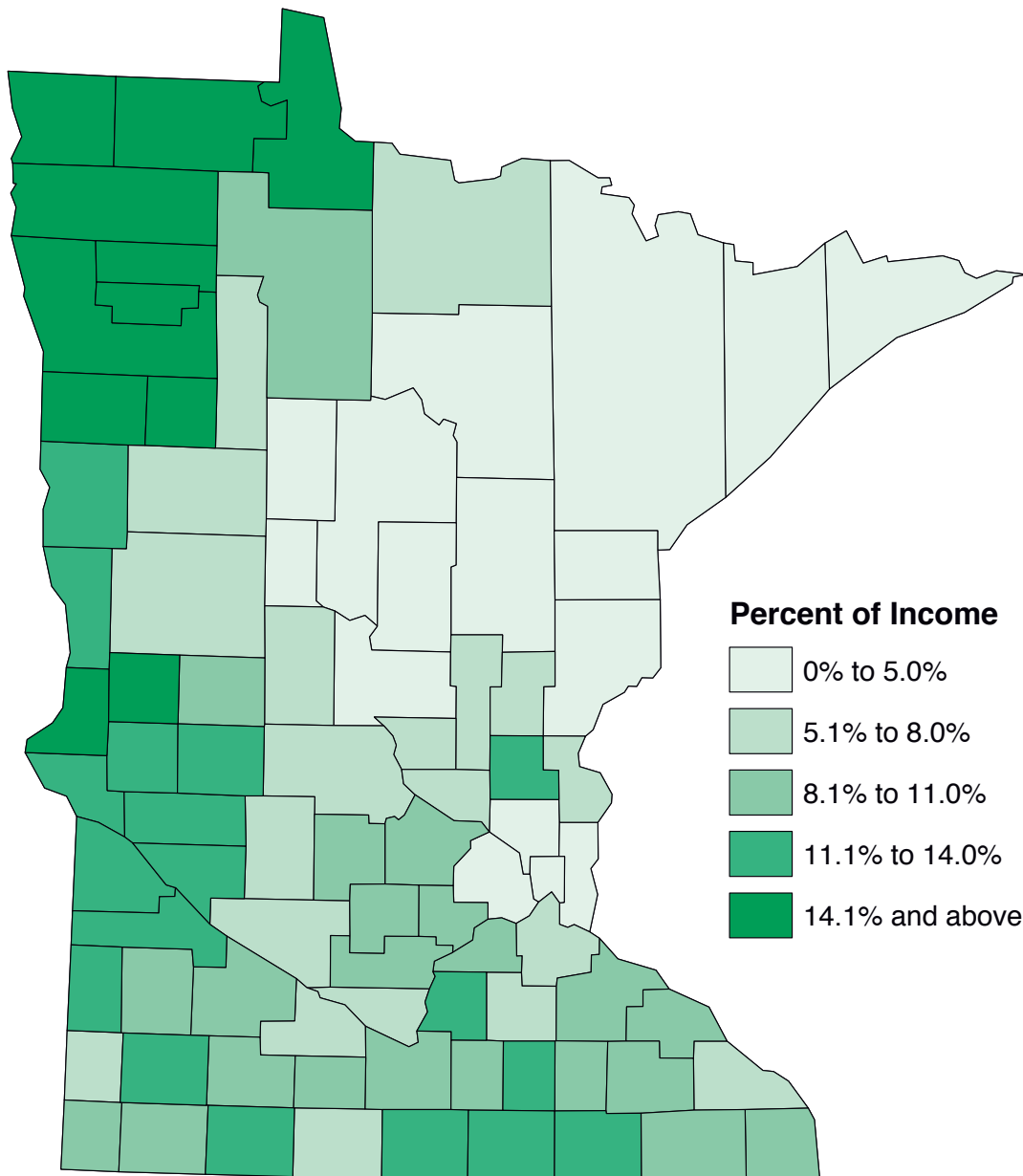


Government Payments as a Percent of Annual Farm Income, 2000–2004

The government payments referred to in this map are federal farm payments. Statewide, for the five-year period 2000-2004, the bulk of these payments (65%) are attributable to agricultural commodity programs. The other 35% is attributable to agricultural emergency/disaster programs (27%), such as flood-related crop loss assistance, and conservation programs (8%), including primarily the Conservation Reserve Program. The state average for this period was 10.0%.
