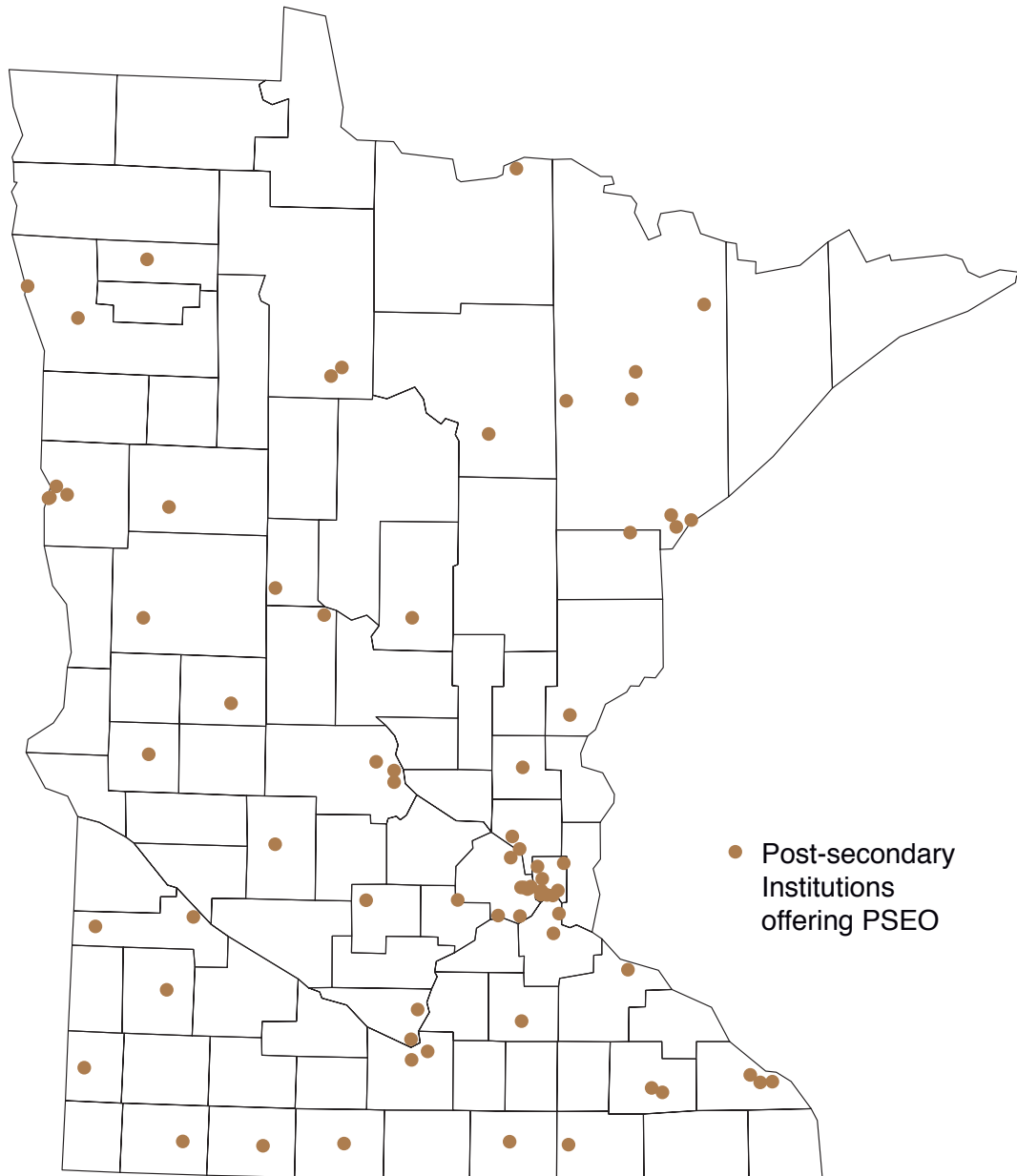


Post-Secondary Education Options Programs, 2006
