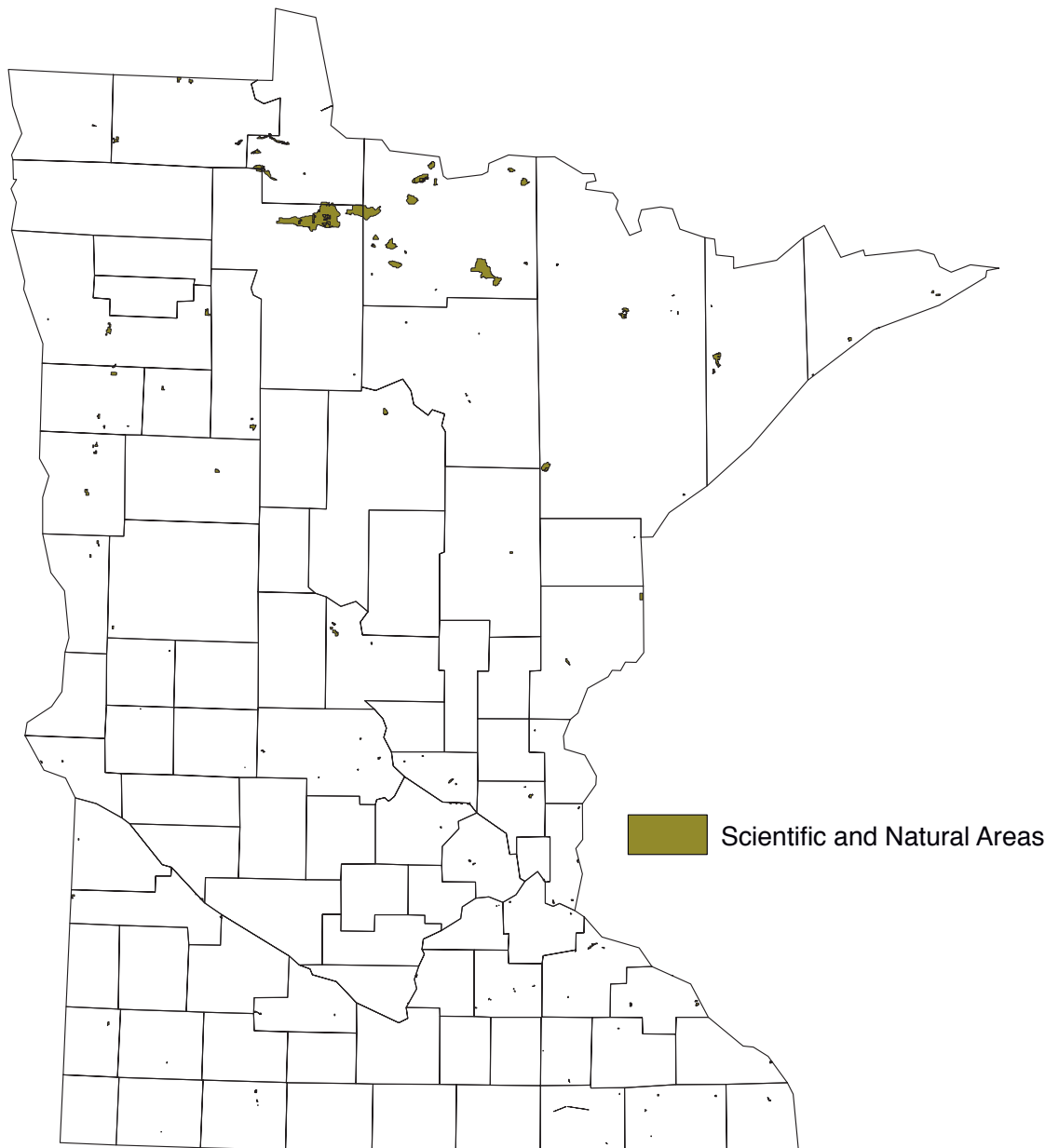


Scientific and Natural Areas
