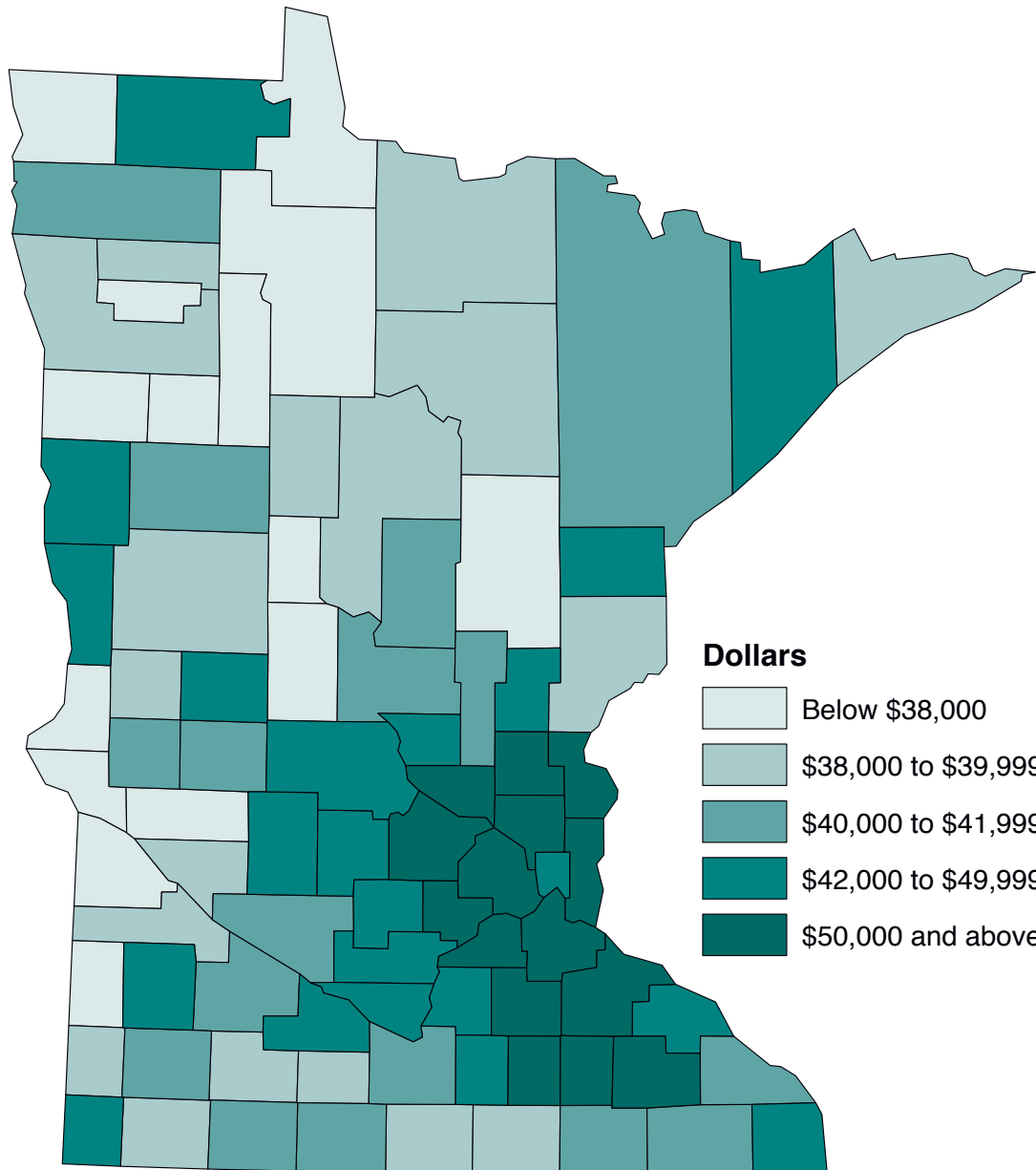


Median Household Income, 2004

In 2004, Minnesota's estimated median household income was \$51,202. Median household income is a frequently used measure showing the point at which half the households of a given geography have a higher income and half have a lower income.

In Minnesota, incomes are highest around the Twin Cities metro area, especially in the more affluent suburban counties that ring the core cities. Scott County had the highest estimated median household income, at \$76,072, while Mahnomon County recorded the lowest, at \$29,645.
