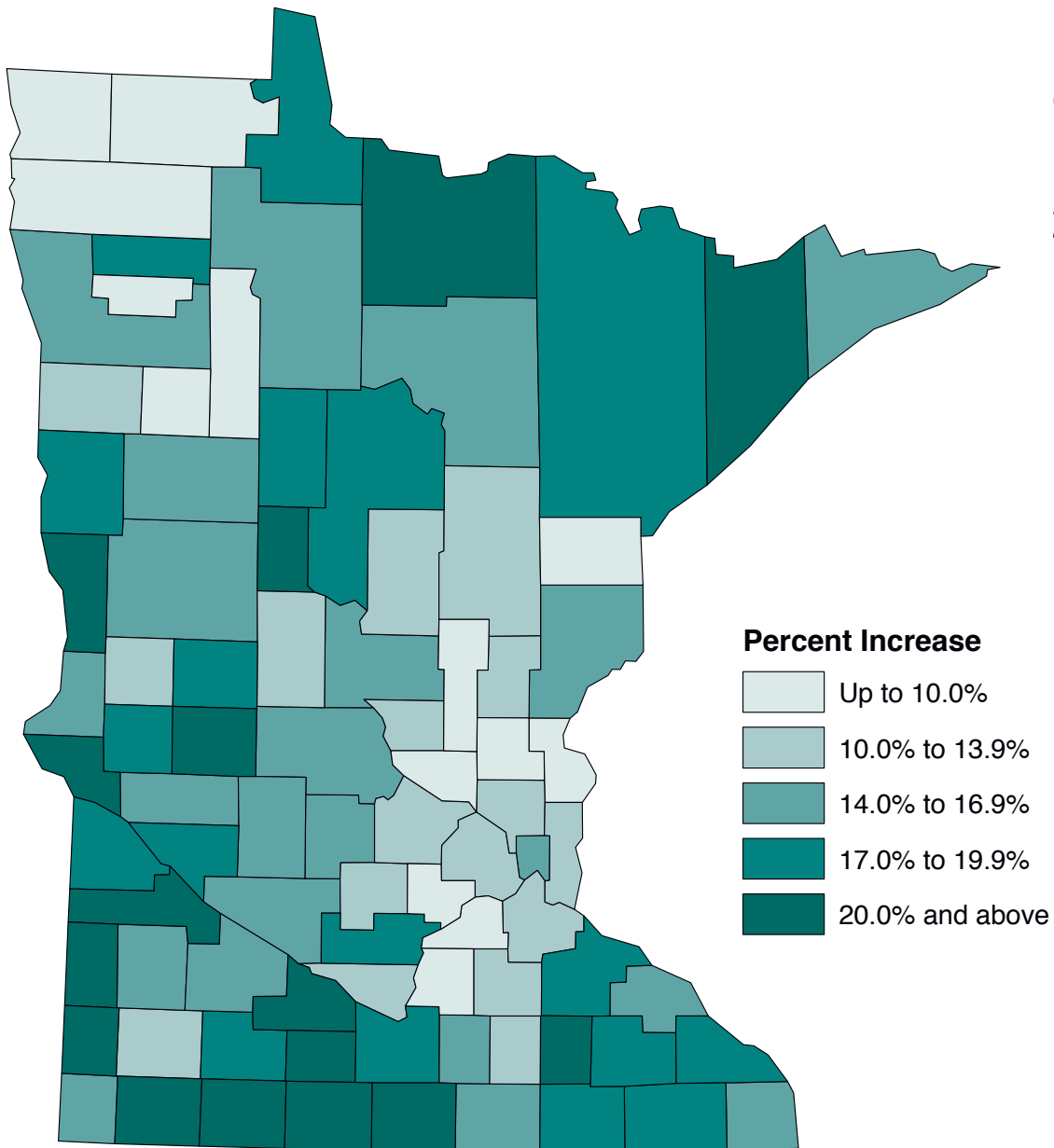


Change in Per Capita Total Personal Income, 2000-2004

The five years from 2000 to 2004 encompass a severe downturn in the nation's economy and a downturn as well in Minnesota. 2000 was the year the boom of the 1990s reached its peak, while in 2004 was on its way to recovery. No counties showed a decrease in per-capita income over that time period, although it is apparent that some counties saw more income growth than others. For the state as a whole, per-capita personal income increased 13.0%.
