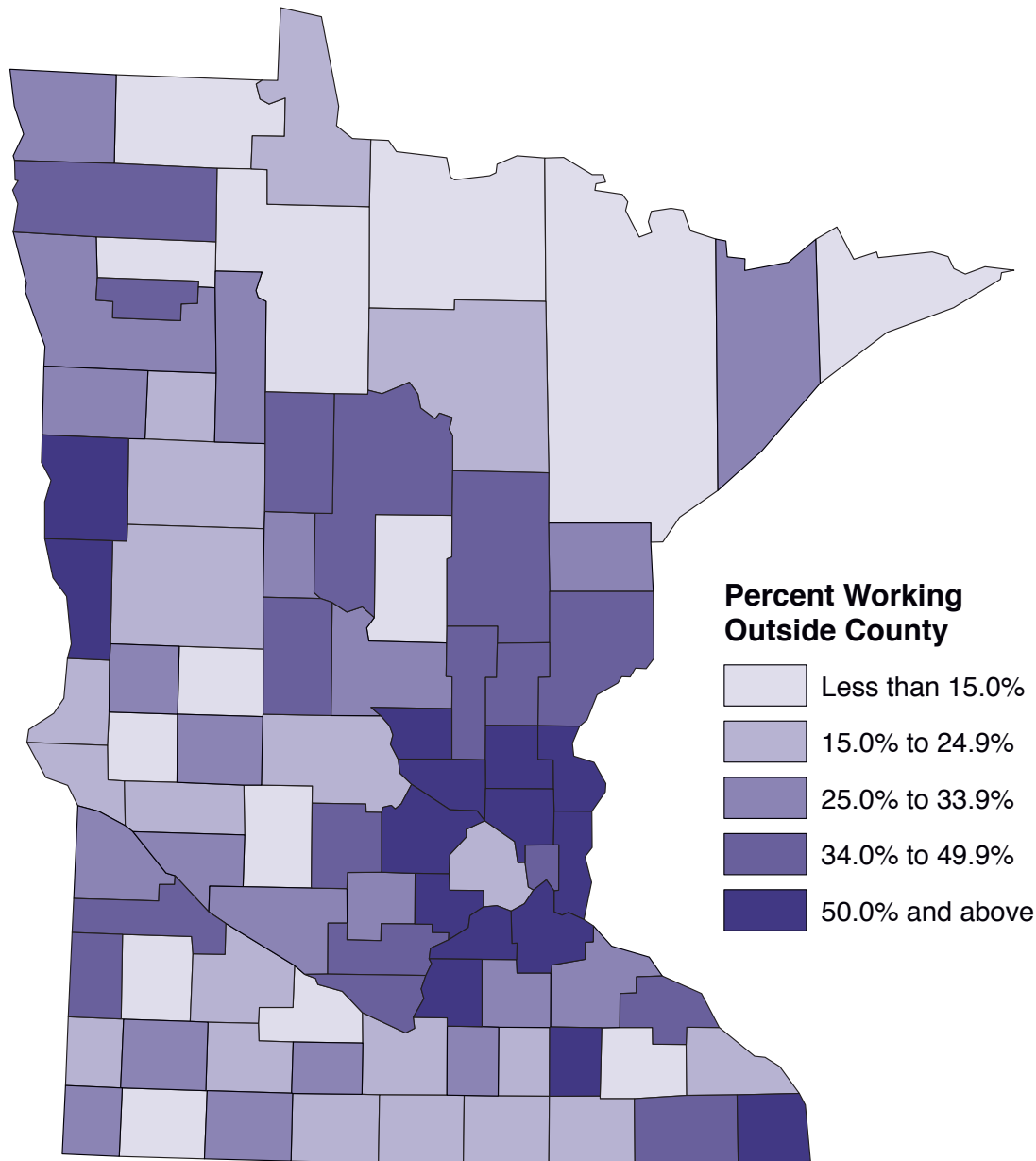


## Working Outside County of Residence, 2000

This map helps explain the commuting patterns of the previous map, showing the large number of people who reside in one county and work in another. The phenomenon is particularly strong in the counties surrounding Hennepin and Ramsey and in the west near Fargo. The state average was 33.7% of county residents working in another county.
