



## Projected Population Change, 2000–2030

Minnesota's State Demographic Center projects that population trends will continue much as they have: the western and southern counties will lose population while growth will continue to radiate out from the Twin Cities and north into the central lakes region. The state's total population is projected to increase by 27% in the next 30 years, but that population will also be aging, perhaps explaining some of the growth projected to take place in the lakes and resort counties.
