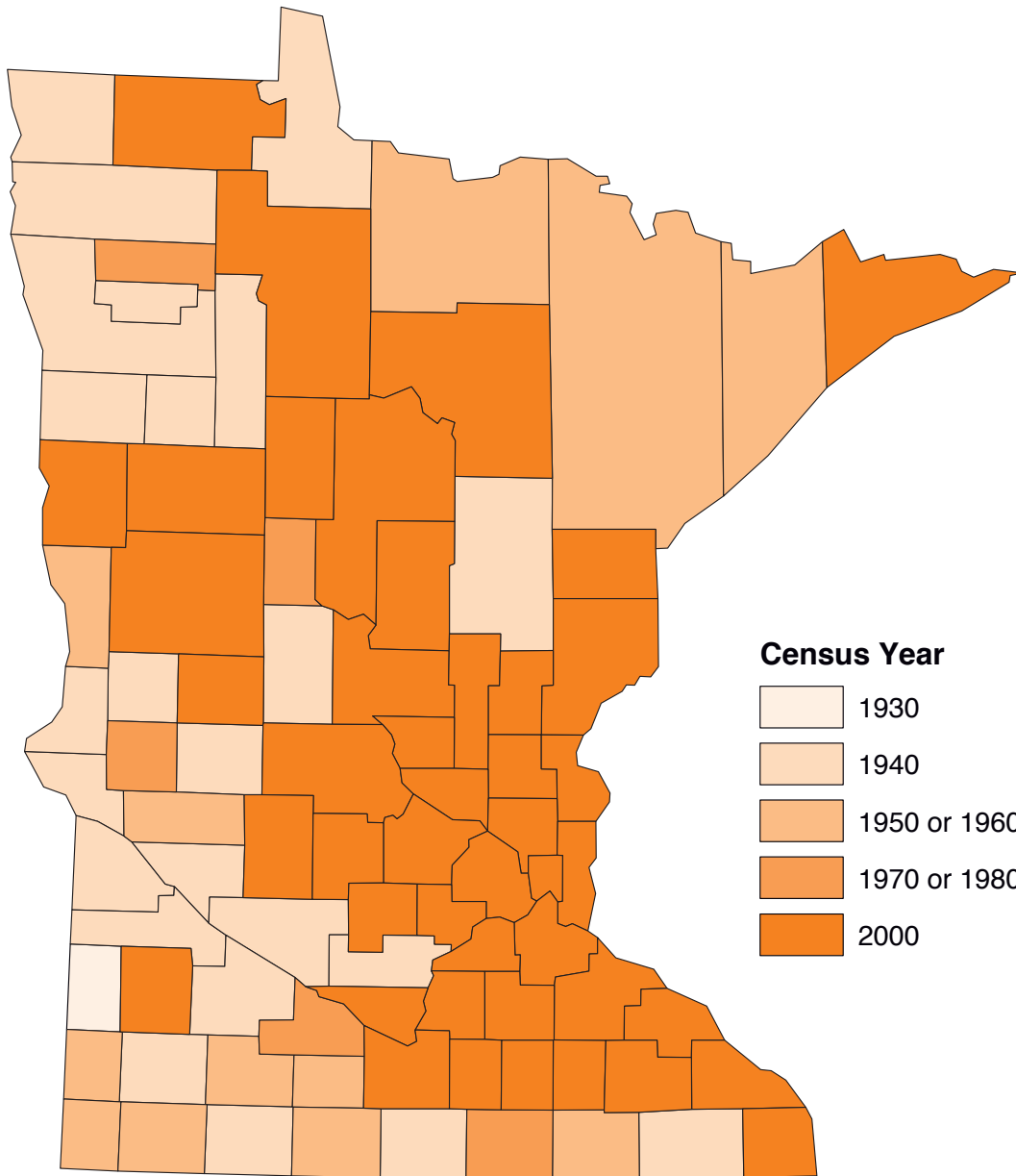


Census Year of Peak Population

Another indication of the population shift occurring in Minnesota, peak population shows the Census year in which a county reported its highest population. While the population of many western and southern counties peaked with the 1940 Census or earlier, about half the counties reported peak populations in the 2000 Census.
