

H1N1 Vaccine for Pregnant Women is Now Available at Student Health Services

Student Health Services has received a very limited supply of H1N1 vaccine specifically designated for PREGNANT WOMEN. Unfortunately, at this time this is the only population we will be able to vaccinate given the type of doses we have received. If you are pregnant, we will be holding a vaccination clinic Monday, November 9, 2009 from 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. in 100 Carkoski Commons (next to Carkoski Dining Hall). Please bring your Tech ID to verify that you are an MSU student. Anyone who comes hoping to get vaccinated that is not pregnant will be turned away. If you are pregnant and are unable to come at this time, you can make an appointment for your vaccine starting Tuesday, November 10 after 9:00 a.m. by calling the Student Health Services at 389-6276. Make sure you tell the staff exactly what the appointment is for and verify that you are pregnant. There is no cost for this vaccine.

There will be additional vaccine coming. The doses we have now are specifically for pregnant women not able to receive some of the other forms of the vaccine. We know there are others who are also in high risk groups and will inform the campus community when we get additional doses.
