# MSU women's hockey squad can't hold lead vs. Badgers

**MADISON, WIS.** — The Minnesota State women's hockey team had a pair of one-goal leads but couldn't score its first-ever victory over Wisconsin, losing 4-2 to the second-ranked Badgers Saturday.

Minnesota State took a 1-0 lead on freshman Lisa Edman's first collegiate goal at 2:50 of the first period. Freshman Nina Tikkinen gave the Mavericks a 2-1 lead just 31 seconds into the second period.

But Wisconsin scored three unanswered goals, including Kyla Sanders' game-tying goal at 12:26 of the second period and Hilary Knight's game-winner on a breakaway with 4:05 remaining in the third.

Mavericks goaltender Britni Kehler made 34 saves in the loss. Minnesota State

had 18 shots on goal.

Minnesota State (1-4-1, 1-2-1 in WCHA) will host St. Cloud State Thursday at All Seasons Arena.

### Volleyball

Carlie Christensen had 12 kills to lead Nebraska-Omaha to a three-game sweep over 12th-ranked Minnesota State in a North Central Conference volleyball match.

Games scores were 30-26, 30-23, 30-22.

Ashley Nachreiner led Minnesota State with 13 kills and 10 digs.

Setter Stef Sandstrom also had a double-double with 32 set assists and 15 digs. Dana Ostertag added 14 digs, and libero Kelly Sandstrom had 12.

Minnesota State (17-7, 5-4 in NCC) will host St. Cloud State Friday.
