**Press Row:** The working press row for MSU volleyball matches is located courtside in Taylor Center. Check with a member of the MSU Athletic Communications staff for seating.

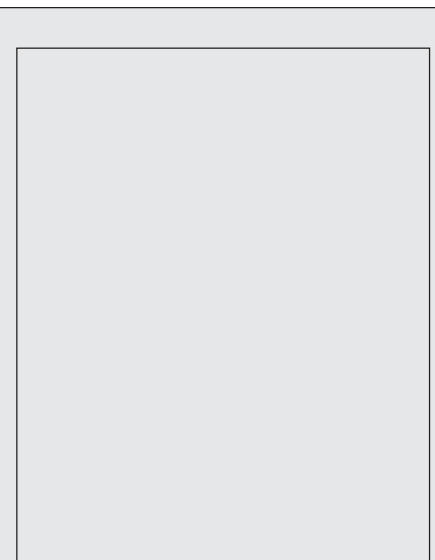

## COACHING STAFF



**Dennis Amundson**  
**Head Coach**

**Dennis Amundson**, the seventh head coach in the history of the Minnesota State University volleyball program, comes to MSU after spending the 2004 season as an assistant coach at the University of St. Thomas. There, he was responsible for technical training, scouting, defensive systems and recruiting. Prior to his stint with the Tommies, he enjoyed eight seasons as a volunteer assistant coach at the University of Minnesota. From 1996 to 2003, he helped lead the Gophers to seven NCAA tournament appearances, five Sweet 16 appearances, one regional and Big Ten title and an appearance in the Final Four. Amundson has been involved with club volleyball programs in the upper Midwest since 1987, guiding the Mosquito Coast junior Olympic team during that time. He also guided St. Paul Harding High School to three state tournament ap-

pearances ('87, '98, '91).

“Across the state of Minnesota and throughout the upper Midwest, Coach Amundson has established a reputation as being a premier coach, strategist and clinician,” MSU Director of Athletics **Kevin Buisman** said. “He is highly regarded by coaches and student-athletes at both the high school and college level and is renowned for his ability in terms of player development. His experiences have put him in contact and allowed him to train some elite players in this region, including some that have competed at the Olympic level.

“Coach Amundson has established an outstanding array of personal contacts, and his network will make him an invaluable asset to our program. He comes to us highly recommended by many of his peers, and I am confident that MSU volleyball will flourish under his direction.”



**Heather Bitz**  
**Assistant Coach**

A Warrod, Minn., native, **Heather Bitz** comes to Minnesota State University after a successful volleyball career at North Dakota State University from 1998-2001. During that time, the Bison earned three North Central Conference championships, captured two NCAA regional titles and made two NCAA Division II Elite Eight appearances. Bitz, who graduated from

NDSU in 2003, was an assistant coach with the women’s volleyball program at the College of St. Benedict during the 2003-04 school year and served as a student assistant coach at NDSU in 2002-03.

A veteran coach with the Junior Olympic volleyball programs in Fargo, N.D., Warroad, Minn., and Maple Grove, Minn., Bitz spent the 2004 season playing professional volleyball in Evreux, France.

“Heather is a self-made player who comes from a championship program and knows what it takes to compete at the highest levels,” MSU head coach **Dennis Amundson** said. “She is familiar with competition in

the North Central Conference, and we feel fortunate to have Heather on board as we work towards establishing Minnesota State as a championship program.”

Prior to MSU, she played volleyball for the University of North Dakota, helping the team to back-to-back NCAA Division II Championship appearances in 2002 and 2003. ## 2005 SEASON OUTLOOK



Middle hitter **Tiffany Graham** will anchor the Maverick frontline this season.

As the saying goes, “out with the old, in with the new.” And this season, a lot of things will be new for the Minnesota State University volleyball program.

With the entrance of a new coaching staff led by **Dennis Amundson**, the Mavericks will begin the 2005 season on a quest to improve upon last season’s 10-17 overall and 3-9 North Central Conference records.

“Our main goal this season is to always focus on the process of volleyball,” said Amundson, who will begin this season as the seventh volleyball coach in Minnesota State history, replacing seven-year head coach **Doug Tully**. “With a brand new staff and new players, there will be a lot to teach and learn. Our long-term goals will be woven into everything we do.”

In addition to Amundson and new assistant coach **Heather Bitz** (North Dakota State ‘03), the Mavericks will be joined by new graduate assistant coach **Lori Rittenhouse** (Wisconsin ‘03) and volunteer assistant coach

**Jamie Skadeland** (North Dakota ‘05).

Although many unfamiliar faces will make up this season’s MSU coaching staff, a few familiar faces will return to the court.

The Mavericks only graduated three players last season and will return senior middle hitter **Tiffany Graham**, who was an *All-NCC* and *Academic All-NCC honorable mention* selection last season after posting a team-high 127 blocks and .321 hitting percentage. Graham was also selected to the 2005 *Daktronics All-North Central Region Second Team*.

Returning alongside Graham will be sophomore middle hitter **Megan Stroud**, who recorded 121 kills and 99 blocks in 2004, in addition to junior outside hitter **Cassie Wolpern**, an *All-NCC honorable mention* selection a year ago after leading MSU with 361 kills.

“We’ll have a very young team,” Amundson said, noting the Mavericks will rely on four other returners and look to ten promising newcomers. “Many athletes played last year, but we’ll conduct an open competition where the best performers will play. With the new players and new staff, we plan to take baby steps while still focusing on the process of getting better everyday.”

MSU will open its season by hosting the *AmericInn Back-to-School Bash* August 26-27. Teams involved will be Saginaw Valley State University, Bemidji State University and Michigan Tech University. MSU opens play on August 26 at 2:30 p.m. against Saginaw Valley State.

## Q & A

With MSU Volleyball Head Coach **Dennis Amundson**

**Q:** *Since this will be your first season with the Mavericks, can you describe what your adjustment has been like?*

**A:** My adjustment has been made easy by the great people, administrators and coaches of MSU. There are a lot of people out there who support Minnesota State athletics, and I’m excited to be a part of such a great program.

**Q:** *How would you describe your coaching style?*

**A:** I love to teach, and since we have a lot of things to learn, we’re intending to teach everyday. We will be teaching an aggressive, up-tempo style of play.

**Q:** *What are some season-long goals you have already set?*

**A:** The answer to this question is the same every year. We will be looking to hang a banner in the gym. However, there are some things we need to do first. With eight new players, we have to discover who we are, then we have to extend our range as players and finally learn to compete.

**Q:** *What are your thoughts about coaching in the NCAA Division II North Central Conference?*

**A:** The first time through for any new coach is always difficult. As of right now, I know this conference is one of the highest level Division II conferences in the nation, and I’m ready and excited to take on the challenge.

**Q:** *Describe what your assistant coaches will bring to the team.*

**A:** All three assistants (Bitz, Rittenhouse and Skadeland) have something in common: they’re young and eager to learn how to coach. I know that all three will model the championship behavior I want my players to learn.

**Q:** *Who are your key returners and promising newcomers?*

**A:** We’ll have a very young team, and although many of the players played last year, we’ll conduct an open competition where the best performers will play.

## NORTH CENTRAL CONFERENCE



Representatives of colleges and universities in North Dakota, South Dakota, Iowa, Nebraska, and Minnesota met in the late fall of 1921 in Chicago to consider the formation of what was to become the North Central Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, now commonly known as the North Central Conference or NCC.

There were representatives from nine institutions at the meeting: North Dakota Agricultural College (now NDSU), the University of North Dakota, State University of South Dakota, South Dakota State College, Morningside College, Des Moines Municipal University, Nebraska Wesleyan, College of St. Thomas and Creighton University.

Shortly after the conference began, it met with some rough going with four members withdrawing. Des Moines Municipal went first, dropping out after the 1926 season. Nebraska Wesleyan severed relationships after the season of 1927. In 1928, St. Thomas and Creighton also became casualties. It was not until 1935 that Omaha University was allowed to join the league. In 1936, Iowa State Teacher's College (now Northern Iowa) was admitted, and in 1941, Augustana College of Sioux Falls was allowed to become a member. Omaha withdrew in 1943, leaving the NCC membership intact until 1968: Morningside, Northern Iowa, North Dakota State, North Dakota, Augustana, South Dakota and South Dakota State.

At the fall meeting in 1968, Minnesota State University, Mankato (known then as Mankato State College) was admitted into the league. The University of Nebraska-Omaha (formerly Omaha University) was readmitted in the spring of 1976. Minnesota State dropped out in the spring of 1977, and Northern Iowa left in the spring of 1978. The University of Northern Colorado became the eighth member of the NCC in January of 1979, and Minnesota State was readmitted along with St. Cloud State University in 1981 to bring the membership to 10.

Recent years have seen plenty of change in the NCC, with charter member Morningside departing after the 2001-02 school year after moving to NAIA affiliation and Northern Colorado leaving the league after 2002-03 to reclassify to NCAA Division I. In addition, the 2003-04 school year was the last in the league for NCC mainstays North Dakota State and South Dakota State, both of which followed UNC's route to NCAA Division I.

To help fill the void left by the departure of those four schools, Minnesota Duluth joined the conference during the 2004-05 school year, joining the league after a stint in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference and bringing the current membership to seven schools. Augustana, Minnesota Duluth, Minnesota State, Nebraska-Omaha, North Dakota, St. Cloud State and South Dakota will comprise the North Central Conference for the upcoming school year and the foreseeable future.

The league offers championships in 10 sports for men, and nine for women. The NCC offices are located in Sioux Falls, S.D.

She is a member of the NCAA Division II Women's Basketball Committee.

**Jon Martin** (info@northcentralconference.org) became the first full-time North Central Conference Director of Media Relations in July of 1998. A Springfield, Mo., native and a graduate of North Dakota State University, Martin owns a master's degree from Minnesota State University, Mankato. Prior to spending two years as a graduate assistant in the sports information office at MSU, Martin also held SID internships at Southwest Missouri State and ESPN. Martin spent the summer of 1996 working as a member of the media relations staff with the Atlanta local organizing committee for the Summer Olympics and served as the venue press chief for curling at the 2002 Winter Olympics in Salt Lake City.
