Maverick women skate past North Dakota

MANKATO — The Minnesota State women's hockey team skated to a 3-3 tie against North Dakota Saturday at All Seasons Arena against North Dakota, but won the shootout 2-1. The Mavericks received goals from Christina Lee and Maggie Fisher to win the Western Collegiate Hockey Association game.

The Mavericks owned a one-goal lead after one period with an even-strength score by Emmi Leinonen at 18:12. Ashley Young added

a short-handed goal at 5:28 of the second period to put MSU ahead by 2.

UND responded, however, with three goals in five minutes in the second period to take a 3-2 lead. Fisher scored her seventh goal of the season at 15:21 of the second to tie the game for MSU. MSU outshot UND 14-10 in the third but neither team could find the net.

Kala Buganski, Fisher and Lee had assists for MSU.

Freshman goaltender Ali Altmann made 43 saves for the Mavericks, allowing three goals, and stopping two shootout attempts by UND.

MSU (6-14-3, 3-13-3-2) and UND play Game 2 of the series at 3:07 p.m. today at All Seasons Arena.
