## Maverick women win first shootout

**GRAND FORKS, N.D.** —

The Minnesota State University women's hockey team needed a five-round shootout to earn its first two Western Collegiate Hockey Association points of the season Friday. The Mavericks tied the University of North Dakota 2-2, but won 2-1 in the five-round shootout.

Sophomore forward Lisa Edman scored the game-winning goal in the shootout. Junior forward Christina Lee tallied the other goal for MSU.

In regulation, MSU scored a 4-on-4 goal at the 10-minute mark when Lee delivered her third goal of the season. Lee picked-up a rebound all alone in front of UND goaltender Brittany Kirkham, made one move to her left and slid the puck past the red line. Amy Udvig and Nina Tikkinen had assists.

UND answered with two straight goals from Alyssa Wiebe and Sara Dagenais. The Mavericks didn't let UND celebrate long as junior forward Ashley Young scored shorthanded at 8:52 of the third. Emilia Andersson got

the assist.

In the shootout, Christina Lee and Edman scored MSU's goals.

UND had a 2-on-1 with three minutes remaining in the overtime session, but goaltender Alli Altmann stuffed any chance for a UND victory. In all, UND had five shots in the extra frame.

UND outshot MSU 34-30 for the game. The Mavericks (3-1-1) close out the two-game series at 2:07 p.m. today in Grand Forks.
