Mav women win in OT

GRAND FORKS, N.D. — MSU roundup

Nina Tikkinen scored 2:46 into overtime to lift the Minnesota State women's hockey team to a 5-4 win over North Dakota Saturday afternoon.

Tikkinen also assisted on teammate Kala Buganski's game-tying goal, which came with an extra attacker on the ice with just 11.7 seconds remaining in regulation. Buganski, who scored twice in the game, already has eight goals in the Mavericks' first six games.

The Mavericks (4-1-1, 1-0-1 in WCHA) led 2-0 on first-period goals by Emilia Anderson and Buganski. The Sioux stormed back with four consecutive goals — two in the first period and two in the second — before Ashley Young scored on an assist from Buganski to cut it to a one-goal game with 4:13 remaining in regulation.

The Mavericks outshot the Sioux 39-28. Alli Altmann stopped 24 shots in the win.

Minnesota State will continue its road swing Friday when it begins a two-game series at Minnesota Duluth.

Women's soccer

Minnesota State had its nine-game unbeaten streak snapped and suffered its

first Northern Sun loss of the season when it fell 1-0 at Augustana.

Katelyn Ley's goal in the 70th minute gave the Vikings the 1-0 victory.

The Augustana goalkeeper made seven saves for the shutout win as the Mavericks outshot the Vikings 24-10.

Sheila Reynolds made four saves for Minnesota State (8-2-2, 6-1-1 in NSIC), who will play at 1 p.m. today at Wayne State (Neb.).

Volleyball

Brittany Stamer of Minnesota State delivered 50 assists Saturday in a NSIC loss at St. Cloud State. The match scores were 27-25, 25-20, 18-25, 21-25, 15-10.

Amanda Beekman led the Mavericks at the net, tying her career high with 27 kills. Ashley Nachreiner had 20 digs and teammate Alecia Fruechte added 19.

Jennifer Waterman tallied 47 assists for St. Cloud and teammate Andrea Pieper had 36 digs.

The Mavericks (13-10, 8-4 NSIC) play at home Friday against Wayne State.
