Ohio State edges Maverick women 3-2

COLUMBUS, OHIO — Ohio State scored the game-winning goal with less than two minutes to play, handing Minnesota State a 3-2 Western Collegiate Hockey Association loss Friday.

The Buckeyes had a 1-0 lead after the first period, but MSU managed to take a 2-1 lead just before the 10-minute mark in the second.

Amanda Stohr opened the scoring for the Mavs with her sixth goal of the season before

Christina Lee's eighth goal of the year gave MSU the lead.

Ohio State tied the game later in the second before putting away the game-winner while on a power play late in the third.

MSU's Britni Kehler stopped 38 shots, including 19-of-20 in the first period.

Minnesota State split two games on the second day of the Schutt Sport/Division II

Lead-Off Classic Friday, beating No. 10 Cal-State Stanislaus 11-5 before losing to San Francisco State 5-0.

Libbie Reichling went 2 for 3 with a two-run home run in the victory. Seniors Lynndi Decker and Abby Wagner both went 3 for 4 with Wagner driving in two runs and scoring three while Decker drove in another.

The Mavericks managed just three hits in the 5-0 loss to San Francisco State.

MSU lost its season opener the day before, a 3-1 setback to Eastern New Mexico, before crushing Western Washington 10-0 in six innings.

Natalie Spicer hit her first-career home run and scored four times in the win over Western Washington. Senior Samantha Rohr pitched a complete game, striking out three.

Minnesota State (2-2) continues play at the Schutt Sport/Division II Lead-Off Classic today.
