MSU wrestlers bounce back with big win

MANKATO — The fourth-rated Minnesota State wrestling team bounced back after two straight Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference losses with a 36-12 win against the University of Mary Saturday at Bresnan Arena.

The Mavericks won eight of the 10 matches and earned bonus points in five of them, starting with Andy Fostner. The junior grabbed a 14-3 major decision at 125 pounds.

Robby Fisher led the 141-pound match 16-4 in the third period before he got a pin at 5:47. Tel Todd (165 pounds) and Ben Becker (174) delivered pins in 6:08 and 4:24, respectively.

Top-ranked heavyweight Brady Wilson picked up his 22nd victory of the season with a 20-5 technical

Minnesota the lead for good.

Terra Rasmussen and Anne Schleper scored third-period goals for the Gophers. Brittany Francis assisted on Minnesota's last three goals and scored the first one. Sarah Erickson assisted on two goals.

Ally Altmann made 27 saves for the Mavericks.

The Mavericks had 10 athletes finish in the top three in their respective events on the second day of the MSU Open Saturday at Myers Field House.

Denise Makoya won the 600-meter run in 1:22.12 for the Mavericks. Sam Lance took first in the 400-meter run in 49.24. Dan Novak won the pole vault at 15 feet-9.75.

Adam Endres finished second in the 400-meter run in 50.00. Matt Masloski placed second in the pole vault at 15-5.75 and Nick Yenser took third at 15-1.75. Todd Reed took third in the 800-meter run in 1:57.06.

Jesse Merkel placed third in the 5,000-meter run in 15:54.73. Todd DeJong placed third in the weight throw with a 52-2.50 throw. Teammates Adedayo Ologunde and Jared Van Dorpe tied for third in the high jump at 6-2.75.

Women's track

Brittany Henderson won the 200-meter dash in 25.64 and took second in the 400-meter dash in 57.79 to lead the Mavericks on

the second day of the MSU Open Saturday at Myers Fieldhouse.

Lauren Stelten won the pole vault with a leap of 13 feet-4.25.

Whitney Kroschel took second in the pole vault at 11-8.00 and Lisa Stocker tied for third in the pole vault at 11-2.25 for MSU. Becca Schmidt finished second in the 60-meter dash in 7.73 for the Mavericks, and Linnelle Clark placed fourth in the same race with a time of 7.85.

Katie hopper finished third in the 60-meter hurdles in 9.67. Lauren Beukelman took fifth in the 600-meter run in 1:39.55. Natalie Lyster placed fifth in the 800-meter run with a time of 2:18.50.

MSU's 4x400 relay team placed second with a time of 3:58.76.
