## MSU baseball team splits twice

**CAROLLTON, GA.** — The Minnesota State baseball team split a doubleheader with West Georgia for the second straight day on Saturday. MSU (6-3) lost the first game 3-0 but took the second 2-1.

Danny Klous took the loss in the first game, allowing three runs on four hits and fanning eight in six innings.

In the second game, pitchers Pat Lenton and Nick

Fellman combined on a two-hitter, with Lenton getting the win, allowing one run over the final five innings. He fanned six straight to end the game.

The Mavericks game-winning run came when Nick Gonzalez singled and came in to score on Jay Bresnahan's sacrifice bunt.

On Friday, Minnesota State lost the first game 7-6 and won the second 8-4.

In the opener, Eric Austvold was 2 for 4 with two RBIs, and Pat Ottum homered.

Dane Secott scattered six hits and fanned seven over the first five innings. Lee Hodges got the loss in relief.

In the nightcap, Dan Woodall was 3 for 3 and Jay Bresnahan had three hits and three RBIs.

Jon Bjelland got the win on a three-hitter.
