MSU baseball squad sweeps Post

FORT PIERCE, FLA. — Senior right-hander Danny Klous fired a three-hit shutout Sunday, leading the Minnesota State baseball team to a 5-0 win over Post University of New York in the first game of a non-conference doubleheader.

Klous struck out six and walked one in improving his record to 2-1. Zach Danelson, Nick Gonzalez and Jay Bresnahan had two hits apiece for the Mavericks.

MSU completed the sweep with a 12-5 win in Game 2. The Mavericks exploded for six runs in the bottom of the second inning for their third straight win.

Bresnahan had three hits and drove in three runs to pace the MSU offense. Gonzalez and Kyle Hoover both contributed a pair of hits and scored twice.

Freshman righty Patrick Lenton allowed one earned run and limited post to six hits in five innings of work to earn his second win of the season.

MSU (11-4) continues action in the Sunshine State at 4 p.m. today with a single nine-inning game against Northwood of Michigan.
