M&M Club leads MSU to 2nd-round win

EMPORIA, KAN. — Danny Miller hit a three-run home run, and Matt Mathiowetz pitched a three-hit shutout Friday to keep the Minnesota State baseball team alive in the NCAA Division II Central Regional.

The Mavericks defeated Concordia-St. Paul 6-0 at Glennon Field.

Miller, a freshman from Eden Prairie, hit his fourth home run of the season in the fourth inning to give Minnesota State a 3-0 lead. The Mavericks added three runs in the bottom of the seventh with a two-run single by Zach Danelson and a Jay Bresnahan sacrifice fly that scored Danelson.

Meanwhile, Mathiowetz went the distance, striking out eight and walking two to improve his record to 6-4. Mathiowetz also went 3 for 4 with a double.

MSU (28-24) will play an elimination game at 3:30 p.m. today against the loser of the Nebraska-Omaha vs. Central Missouri game.
