Gordon, Bulls outlast
Celtics in double OT

Glynn, Miller power MSU

WAYNE, NEB. — Geno Glynn smacked four hits and Danny Miller drove in three runs as the Minnesota State University baseball team defeated Wayne State 13-10 in the first game of a Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference doubleheader Sunday. Wayne State came back to win the nightcap 9-1.

In the opener, Kosuke Hattori, Jay Bresnahan, Miller, Travis Taran, Aaron Berner and Corey LaPlante all had two hits for the Mavericks. Glynn, LaPlante and Matt Kuchenbecker each ripped home runs.

Hattori, Taran, Kuchenbecker and LaPlante drove in two runs apiece. Pat Lenton got the win, pitching the first four innings and allowing seven earned runs on nine hits.

In Game 2, Wayne State's Troy Doran shut MSU down on three hits. Miller was 2 for 2 with a double to lead MSU.

Brett Fratzke took the loss, lasting just 3 2/3 innings and giving up five earned runs on eight hits.

MSU is now 27-13 overall and 20-4 in the NSIC.
