## Mavericks get even with West Georgia

CARROLLTON, GA. —

After getting swept in a doubleheader Thursday by West Georgia, the Minnesota State baseball team got even on Friday, winning 12-7 and 4-3 in nonconference action.

Minnesota State had 28 hits in two games Friday; the Mavericks managed just six hits Thursday.

The Mavericks belted 17 hits in the opener, including a 4 for 4 performance by Nick Gonzalez. Adam Sudbeck was 3 for 4, Mark Dolenz went 2 for 4, and Travis Taran was 2 for 2.

Dane Secott got the victory, pitching six innings and giving up nine hits and five runs while striking out three.

The Mavericks had 11 hits in the second game. Sudbeck went 2 for 4 with three RBIs, Scott Kemp was 2 for 2, and Eric Austvold finished 2 for 4.
