## McMurtry sets MSU wins mark in Mavericks' sweep

**SIOUX FALLS, S.D.** — Minnesota State pitcher Matt McMurtry established a school win record, and the Mavericks swept Augustana Tuesday in North Central Conference baseball.

MSU won 9-6 and 4-1, with the senior lefty McMurtry getting the Game 1 win for his 26th career victory to surpass Chris Rupert (1999-2002) on MSU's all-time wins list. McMurtry allowed four runs on seven hits in 4 $\frac{1}{3}$  innings.

Catcher Pat Ottum hit a three-run homer in the second inning, and added a two-run shot in the fourth.

Sophomore closer Nick Fellman earned his 13th save of the year.

Junior righty Ben King went the distance in the second game, holding the Augies to two hits and striking out six.

The Mavericks put the game away in the fifth on RBI singles from Mark Dolenc and Dane Allen, and an RBI sacrifice fly from Adam Sudbeck.

MSU (34-10, 13-1 in the NCC) hosts conference-leading Nebraska-Omaha in a pair of doubleheaders Saturday and Sunday at the MSU Baseball Complex.
