# NCC recognizes Dilling, King

For the sixth time in his career, Minnesota State University junior Jim Dilling has earned the North Central Conference Men's Track and Field Athlete of the Week.

On Saturday in the Drake Relays, in a special edition of the men's high jump, Dilling cleared 7-feet- $\frac{1}{2}$  to finish fourth of eight competitors. The mark is an NCAA Division II provisional qualifying mark but does not better his already established automatic mark of 7-3 $\frac{3}{4}$ , he set at the Stanford Invitational on April 1.

In baseball, MSU pitcher Ben King has been selected the Co-North Central Conference Pitcher of the Week.

King earned a complete-game NCC victory over Augustana Tuesday. The 6-foot-1, 185-pound right-hander held the Vikings to two hits, fanned six and walked one while allowing one earned run in a 4-1 MSU win. On the year he is 5-3 with a 3.19 earned run average and has 56 strikeouts in 53 $\frac{2}{3}$  innings.
