## Mustangs halt Mavericks' baseball winning streak

**MARSHALL** — Southwest Minnesota State ended Minnesota State's 12-game win streak in the first game, but the Mavericks came back in the nightcap to earn a split Wednesday in nonconference baseball.

MSU lost 5-3 before claiming a 16-2 win in the second game.

MSU took a 3-0 lead in

Game 1 when Adam Sudbeck's third-inning single scored two runs, and Dane Allen drove in Sudbeck with a double.

The Mustangs took the lead in the fifth on Colby Pack's three-run homer, and Jake Munsch followed with a solo shot.

MSU's Mark Dolenc went 1 for 3 to extend his hitting

streak to 18 games. Bob Wellman (2-1), the third of four MSU pitchers, took the loss.

In Game 2, the Mavericks erupted for nine runs in the second inning.

Ryan Greene hit his 10th homer of the year and finished with four RBIs.

Eric Austvold doubled and homered for three RBIs, and

designated hitter Mitch Salsbery hit his second homer of the season.

Dolenc (2-1) held the Mustangs to three hits in four innings to get the the win.

MSU (32-10) has North Central Conference double-headers with Augustana Saturday and Sunday in Sioux Falls, S.D.
